## Doune Retail Thermal Printer Upgrade

This publication provides procedures for upgrading the NCR 7709 Receipt Printer from SNBC to Doune Thermal Printer.



**Note:** This kit is compatible with 7709 release version R1.2 only.

## Installation Procedures

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Warning: Before disassembling the kiosk, ensure to properly shut down the Kiosk System Application and to disconnect the AC Power Cable of the kiosk and its peripherals from the AC power source.

To install the Doune Retail Thermal Printer Upgrade kit on an NCR 7709 R1.2 unit, follow these steps:

- 1. To open the NCR 7709 unit, insert the key into the lock at the right-hand side of the kiosk, turn the key clockwise, and then carefully open the front of the kiosk.
- **Caution:** Do NOT abruptly open and release the front of the kiosk. Hold and support the front of the kiosk until fully extended.



- 2. Slide Receipt Printer up into service position.
  - a. Push the printer assembly release rod upward.



- b. Pull the printer assembly backward until fully extended and secured by the green plunger.
  - **Caution:** Ensure that the green plunger holds the printer assembly in place. Do not release the printer assembly if it is not yet secured by the green plunger.



- 3. Remove the cable ties that secure the Receipt Printer Cable and other cables to the Printer Bracket and the Imager Bracket, and then disconnect the Receipt Printer Cable from the motherboard.
  - **Note:** Other cables are not shown in the image.



- 4. Slide the Printer Assembly out of the Printer Bracket.
  - a. Remove the M4 shoulder screw that secures the Printer Assembly to the Printer Bracket.



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- b. Pull the green plunger and slide the assembly out of its bracket.

- 5. Attach the New Printer Service Label.
  - a. Remove the Service Cover. Loosen two thumbscrews, slide the cover downward and lift it up to remove it from the kiosk.



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b. Place the New Printer Service Label over the old printer service label.



c. Re-install the Service Cover. Mount and secure the Motherboard Service Cover. Slide the cover upward and tighten the two thumbscrews.



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6. Remove the SNBC Receipt Printer from the Printer Tray by removing the three M3X6 flat head screws on the bottom.



7. Transfer the two Carriages from the Old Printer Tray to the New Printer Tray that comes with the kit, and then reuse the four M4X6 flat head screws to secure the Carriages.



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8. Mount the Doune Receipt Printer onto the Printer Tray and secure with three M3X6 flat head screws.



- 9. Install the Doune Printer Assembly on the Printer Bracket.
  - a. Slide the assembly onto the bracket until it latches onto the green plunger, putting the printer in service position.



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b. Install the M4 shoulder screw to secure the assembly to the bracket.



- 10. Connect the Printer USB Power Cable.
- **Note:** Other cables are not shown in the image.



- a. Connect the Printer USB Power Cable to the printer, route it towards the motherboard, and connect it to **Port F** of the motherboard.
- b. Use cable ties to secure the Printer USB Power Cable to the Printer Bracket.
- **Note:** There should be enough slack to allow the Printer Tray to slide upward.
- c. Bundle the Printer USB Power Cable together with other cables and use two cable ties to secure them to the Imager Bracket.
- d. Use cable ties to bundle the excess length of the USB Power Cable and tuck the bundle inside the kiosk.
- 11. Slide the Receipt Printer downward into operating position.
- Pull the green plunger and slowly slide the printer assembly downward until the green release rod latches to the printer tray.
