
## TPP Saturn 1000-L Mount

This publication provides procedures for installing the TPP Saturn 1000-L device using a mounting bracket on the NCR SelfServ<sup>™</sup> 90 (7709) Kiosk.



### Installation Procedure




1. Connect the cables to the Saturn 1000-L device.

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- a. Remove the back cover by removing the screw indicated in the above image.
- b. Connect the cables to their corresponding ports.

Note: Cable connections may vary depending on customer configuration.

- c. Reinstall the back cover and secure using the screw.
- 2. Install the Saturn 1000-L onto its mounting bracket.




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- a. Route the cables through the cable access hole on the bracket.
- b. Align the Saturn 1000-L mounting holes with the bracket mounting holes, and then secure the Saturn 1000-L using three M3x8 screws.


- 3. Open the kiosk. Insert the key into the lock, turn the key clockwise, and carefully open the front of the kiosk.
  - For **7709 R1.0 and R1.1** units, the lock is located at the back of the kiosk.
  - For **7709 R1.2 and R2.x** units, the lock is located at the right-hand side of the kiosk.

Caution: Do NOT abruptly open and release the front of the kiosk. Hold and support the front of the kiosk until fully extended.


**Note:** The following image shows a 7709 R1.2 unit.




- 4. Remove the PIN Pad Blank Plate.
  - While holding the PIN Pad Blank Plate from outside the kiosk, loosen the two thumbscrews that secure the Blank Plate to the Display Head, and then remove the Blank Plate.



- 5. Install the Saturn 1000-L Assembly on the Display Head.
  - a. Route the Saturn 1000-L cables through the opening on the Display Head and insert the bracket mounting studs into the Display Head mounting holes





b. Secure the Saturn 1000-L Assembly using two M6 nuts.

c. Connect the cables to their corresponding ports.

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**Note:** Cable connections may vary depending on customer configuration.
