

Introduction

This kit provides the components to install the MSR, Sankyo Dip Reader and NFC feature to an NCR TouchPort 120 (2368) Kiosk.

Installation Procedure




Warning: Disconnect the AC power cord before disassembling the Terminal.




Caution: Static Electricity Discharge may permanently damage your system. Discharge any static electricity build up in your body by touching your computer's case for a few seconds. Avoid any contact with internal parts and handle cards only by their external edges.

To install the MSR, Sankyo Dip Reader and NFC to the NCR TP120 Self Check–In (2368) Kiosk, perform the following steps:


1. Turn the black plastic key counterclockwise to unlock the unit.



2. Pull the Countertop assembly.




3. Remove the screw beside the green plunger on each side of the unit and the screws (2) at the bottom of the Display Head assembly.




- 4. Remove the features installed on the left of the lower fascia.
 - MSR Assembly
 - PIN Pad Assembly


5. Mount the USB Contactless Card Reader Antenna Assembly to the front side of the MSR and NFC Plate Adapter. Secure with two M4 nuts.



6. Place the Cable Clamp around the NFC cable and secure with an M4 Nut.




7. Remove the Sankyo Dip Reader bezel by removing the M2.5 Plastite Screws (2) and washers (2).




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8. Attach the MSR to the Dip MSR/NFC Cradle and secure with the M2.5 plastite screws (2).






9. Mount the NFC assembly to the MSR assembly. Secure with screws (4).




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10. Mount the Dip MSR Cover Bracket on the assembly. Secure with M4 Nuts (3).




11. Install the NFC Label on the front of the Dip MSR and NFC Cradle.




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12. Mount the NFC Controller Module to the chassis. Secure with M3 Hex Nuts (2).



13. Plug the NFC USB Cable from the NFC Controller to the **USB B** port of the I/O Daughtercard. Plug the existing 12V I/O Cable.




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14. Route the Controller Cable and Antenna Wire through the open p-loops (3).




Note: Ensure that the ferrite bead is clamped between the two p-loops.




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Note: Ensure that the antenna cable does not get pinched when the head is closed.


15. Plug the NFC Modular Jack to the controller receptacle and the NFC Antenna Wire to the NFC module.




16. Install the MSR and NFC assembly to the left of the lower fascia.




17. Secure the MSR and NFC assembly by fastening the bracket with M4 Nuts (4).



18. Plug the MSR USB and Power cables to the **USB C** port on the motherboard.




19. Secure the MSR and NFC assembly with screw.




Removing the MSR Assembly

1. Unplug the MSR USB Cable and Power Cable.




2. Remove the M4 nuts (4).




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3. Remove the screw at the bottom of the MSR assembly.




4. Remove the MSR Assembly.
